## Office of Child & Youth Protection—Sexual Abuse

The Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph is committed to combating sexual abuse in the Church. If you are a victim of sexual abuse, or if you observe or suspect sexual abuse:

1. Call the Missouri Child Abuse Hotline at 1.800.392.3738 (if the victim is currently under the age of 18), and
2. Contact your local law enforcement agency or call 911, and
3. After reporting to these civil and law enforcement authorities, report suspected *sexual abuse of a minor or vulnerable adult* to the Diocesan Ombudsman, Joe Crayon, at 816.812.2500, or [crayon@ombudsmankcsj.org](mailto:crayon@ombudsmankcsj.org), if the abuse involves a priest, deacon, employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph.

# Catholic Charities Emergency Assistance Fund

Fr. Bob Stone from Nativity of Mary in Independence, MO-

I hoped that Catholic Charities could do something to keep Larry safe and housed – and that’s exactly what happened.

They found Larry a place to live, moved him out of his current apartment before the eviction date, supplied temporary shelter in a motel until his apartment was ready, and moved him into new, safe and secure living arrangements he could afford – and that also provided him access to other services that he needed.

Our parishioners rallied around him, too. They bought him a bed, donated kitchen appliances, tables and lamps that

made his new apartment a home.

Because Catholic Charities and our parish worked together, Larry was protected and found shelter for the rest of his days.

None of us could have done it alone – but by surrounding him with a circle of support, we kept this vulnerable man from becoming homeless.
