Pastoral Thoughts *Solemnity of the Most holy Trinity*

Trinity Sunday, as it is called by many, is a day for us to reflect on the how The Trinity flows through all of creation. It fills the world we know with beauty, wonder and allows us the capacity to absorb all we see and feel, and experience love.

The 14th-century Dominican mystic, Meister Eckhart, once wrote: "Do you want to know what goes on in the core of the Trinity? I will tell you. In the core of the Trinity, the Father laughs and gives birth to the Son. The Son laughs back at the Father and gives birth to the Spirit. The whole Trinity laughs and gives birth to us."

For Joy permeates through the Trinity and it creates all out of nothing and corrects anything that is not well.

This Mystery of the Most Blessed Trinity is a central mystery of our Christian faith. It is a mystery of God, Himself, that no one is truly able to comprehend the magnitude of His greatness and power.

But, how blessed we are to have a God that suffered for us, so that we have the ability to be saved and live eternity with Him. For the worship of God is the acknowledgement of the truth we have been given and are called to share. For this Truth was first shared with the Jewish people and then completely revealed through Christ to the world.

Published through Arcadia Publishing as part of their popular Images of America series, *Catholic Kansas City* is a pictorial history tracing the earliest foundations of Catholicism in Kansas City during the 1830s up through the second renovation of the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in 2003.

Chapters exploring parishes, diocesan bishops, Catholic education, and more are included in the manuscript. Our Lady of Sorrows is featured in the book.

After reporting to these civil and law enforcement authorities, report suspected *sexual abuse of a minor or vulnerable adult* to the Diocesan Ombudsman, Joe Crayon, at 816.812.2500, or crayon@ombudsmankcsj.org, if the abuse involves a priest, deacon, employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph.
